tary of state Cordel Hull today modified the ban against Americans' traveling on heligereni vessels to permit them to use such ablue un-der cortain conditions across the English Channel, the Irish Sea or 8t George's Channel. "Individuals who possess both American nationality and a foreign nationality, and who habitually re-side in the foreign State of which they are nationals, and who are maing passports of such foreign State," he ruled, "may, while en route to and from such State, travel on a helligerent vessel across the English Channel, the Irish Sea or St. George's Channel without ob-taining specific authority and with-out an American passport endorsed as valid for such travel. "Individuals who undertake travel under conditions indicated shall do so on the understanding that they will look for protection to the for-eign State whose passport they oarry."
