U. S. TRAVEL BAN EASED

**Those With Dual Nationality
May Forego Permission**

WASHINGTON, Dec. 16—Secretary of State Cordell Hull today modified the ban against Americans' traveling on belligerent vessels to permit them to use such ships under certain conditions across the English Channel, the Irish Sea or St. George's Channel.

"Individuals who possess both American nationality and a foreign nationality, and who habitually reside in the foreign State of which they are nationals, and who are using passports of such foreign State," he ruled, "may, while en route to and from such State, travel on a belligerent vessel across the English Channel, the Irish Sea or St. George's Channel without obtaining specific authority and without an American passport endorsed as valid for such travel."

"Individuals who undertake travel under conditions indicated shall do so on the understanding that they will look for protection to the foreign State whose passport they carry."
