3. With regard to the portion of the letter referring to Christmas Island, I am to add, for your information, that Covenant 1 of the Licence dated the 27th October, 1914, to Central Pacific Coccanut Plantations Limited, in respect of that Island, was as follows:-

"That the Licensess will not assign or underlet the present "Licence or any interest therein without having first obtained "the consent thereto in writing of His Majesty's Principal "Secretary of State for the Colonies (hereinafter called "The "Secretary of State").
