O.D.C. Minute No. 343.

All the Departments concerned have now concurred generally in the terms of our draft telegram to Fiji, concerning which you wrote to me in your letter D.255/20 of the 23rd June. The draft has been amended to incorporate minor additions, deletions or alterations suggested by Departments: and a copy of the telegram as sent is being communicated to you officially.

May I take it you will let us know, with reference to paragraph (a) (iv) and (vi) in the telegram when it will be appropriate for the Governor to approach the New Zealand Government as regards the construction of the landing grounds?
