With reference to Sir Ronald Lindsay's note No. 545 of the 18th August, I have the honour under instructions from His Majesty's Principal Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs to transmit to you herewith one certified and two uncertified copies of the International Convention concerning Exemption from Taxation on Fuel and Lubricants used in Air Traffic which was concluded in London on the 1st March 1959.

I am instructed at the same time to inform you that the accession of Denmark to the Convention was notified to the Foreign Office on the 17th July, 1989, in accordance with Article 5 of the Convention, and to state that the reservation in respect of Poland included in the Annex to the Convention was withdrawn by a note from the Polish Ambassador dated the 50th May, 1939.
