With reference to my despatch No. 1075 of the 12th December regarding the ratification of the treaty signed at Washington on the 6th of September last between the United States on the one hand and Canada, Australia and New Zealand on the other, amending the treaty for the advancement of peace between the United States and the United Kingdom of the 15th September, 1914, I have the honour to transmit to you herewith a copy of a note from the Secretary of State informing me that he is prepared to proceed to the exchange of ratifications of the treaty between New Zealand and the United States.
